LANGUAGE TRAINING

French as a Foreign Language / French for Integration

➤ OBJECTIVES

Acquire the language and social skills required for written and oral interactions, daily, for both professional and citizen purposes.

➤ TARGET AUDIENCE

Nationals of non-EU countries residing legally in France, experiencing difficulties in professional integration, including BPI (Beneficiaries of International Protection).

➤ TRAINING ORGANISATION

Mandatory requirement: RSA beneficiaries and/or CIR signatories within the last 5 years. Must be available to attend the full training.

➤ TWO TYPES OF TRAINING

Open-entry / open-exit sessions

- 4 groups : A1.1/A1/A2/B1 (CECRL) levels
- 200 hours at a pace of 12 hours /week
- 50 hours for people with employment difficulties(renewable if necessary)

Intensive training sessions

4 groups : A1/A2/B1/B2 (CECRL) levels
400 hour sessions, at a pace of **26 hours / week 4 jours** per week


